General Competition Rules & Regulations

- 1. The competition is governed by the rules and regulations of R.S.O.B.H.D.
- 2. Entries will be divided into categories after the closing date. The Competition Committee reserves the right to combine, split, or delete/cancel classes or events at their discretion.
- 3. The competitors age is taken as of the competition date.
- 4. All competitors must **present their current 2025 RSOBHD** registration cards to receive awards and must be in costume to receive awards.
- Competitors dance in inverse order of entry. Any competitor not on hand when his/her event is called will forfeit his/her entry in that event.
- 6. All fees are non-refundable.
- 7. Prize Money will be awarded to Premier dancers as follows: 16 yrs & over: 1^{st} \$40, 2^{nd} \$30, 3^{rd} \$20, 4^{th} \$10, 5^{th} \$10, 6^{th} \$10
- 8. Choreography: Solo maximum length of 1 1/2 minutes; Small group (3-6 dancers) maximum length of 2 1/2 minutes and large group (7 or more dancers) maximum length of 3 minutes. Judges who have students participating in team/joint choreographies must abide by the 3 month teaching/judging rules as stipulated in the RSOBHD Constitution and Rules book. Choreography music must be emailed to rmmckinnon2@gmail.com by Monday June 16, 2025.
- Pre-Premier status changes must be reported to the Competition Secretary (780) 721-4014 by June 20, 2025. NO CHANGES on competition day.
- 10. Protests must be in writing, signed and given to the Competition Secretary before the end of the competition with a \$25.00 fee. The fee is refundable if the protest is sustained.
