## Championship Rules & Regulations

- 1. Alberta Open Championships are sanctioned and conducted under the rules of the Royal Scottish Official Board of Highland Dancing.
- 2. Entries will only be accepted online. Online entry receipt serves as official confirmation of entry.
- 3. The order to dance will be random draw for the Fling, Sword, and Sean Triubhas. The order for the Reel will be first to enter, last to dance.
- 4. Age as of February 21, 2026.
- 5.Cash awards will be presented as follows: Champion- \$100; 1st RU- \$80; 2nd RU-\$60; 3rd RU- \$50; 4h RU-\$40; 5th RU- \$30.
- 5. Dancers must perform the 2026 Championship steps.
- 6. Additional adjudicators may be added at the discretion of the Organizing Committee, without any advance public notice.
- 7. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to combine, split or delete/cancel classes according to the entries received.
- 8. Pre-Championship entry is restricted to Premier dancers who have not previously won a Pre-Championship or Championship.
- 9.All fees are non-refundable

## Competition Rules and Regulations

- 1. Competition will be governed by the rules and regulations of the Royal Scottish Official Board of Highland Dancing.
- 2. Age as of February 21, 2026, for Highland Competition. Age as of February 22, 2026, National Competition.
- 3. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to combine, split or delete/cancel classes according to the entries received.
- 4. Entries will only be accepted online. Online entry receipt serves as official confirmation of entry.
- 5. All competitors must present their 2026 RSOBHD Dancer Registration cards to pick up their numbers and to receive awards. All competitors must remain in costume for all award presentations.
- 6. Prize Money will be awarded to Premier dancers 16 Years & older on February 22nd (Open National Competition) only -1st \$50; 2nd \$40; 3rd \$30; 4th \$30; 5th, 6th \$20.
- 7. All status changes must be reported no later than 6 days prior to the competition. Please send status changes to <a href="mailto:rmmckinnon2@gmail.com">rmmckinnon2@gmail.com</a>
- 8. The judge's decision is final. Any protests must be in writing, signed and handed to the Organizing Committee before the end of the championship or competition day, accompanied by a fee of \$35.00 that will be refunded if the protest is sustained
- 9. Additional adjudicators may be added at the discretion of the Organizing Committee, without any advance public notice.
- 10.All fees are non-refundable.

## Choreography Rules and Regulations

- 1. Pre-Premier and Premier dancers may enter the choreography event.
- 2. Average age determined based on the age of dancer on February 22, 2026.
- 3. Choreography: Must be Scottish or Celtic in appearance and theme including costume and music.
- 4. Time limits: 3 minutes group dances.
- 5. All dancers must email their music in an MP3 or MP4 format to rmmckinnon2@gmail.com by February 6, 2026.
